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again to make change and we have not seen that change occur. I think the federal sanctions that are out there are real and legitimate. I know Senator Chambers would refute that, but I think the 55 mile per hour speed limit has served us well. It's not wise to take a lot of time to deal with this issue at this late date and amend another bill and I know you've already been lobbied by Senator Chambers and the votes are there, but I, for the record, would object and ask you to reconsider your support for the effort and again recognize the consequences of your action, especially with the federal standards that we're talking about.

PRESIDENT: The Chair would interrupt debate to announce that Senator Sieck has guests in the north balcony. They are 45 adults from the York County Extension Club of York. We want to welcome you to the Legislature today and thank you for coming down on a spring day to watch our deliberations. If you will stand, we'd like to thank you and recognize you. All right, on the Chambers motion to suspend rules. Senator Hefner.

SENATOR HEFNER: Mr. President, members of the body, could I ask Senator Chambers a question? Senator Chambers, did this...what are you trying to amend in this? Is this increasing the speed limit?

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Yes, just as Senator Wesely said.

SENATOR HEFNER: Did this have a public hearing?

SENATOR CHAMBERS: As I stated before, not only did it have a public hearing and a bill, but it was advanced and the bill sits on General File.

SENATOR HEFNER: Oh, okay. Well, I still oppose it. I don't think we ought to be doing these things and we only have three more days left and there is a lot of bills that need to be read on Final Reading so I would urge you to oppose this.

PRESIDENT: Senator Marsh.

SENATOR MARSH: Thank you, Mr. President. I, too, oppose this suspension of the rules. Time is one element, but another very strong element is what we will be doing to our death certificates reports if we would try to put this into law. I would remind you that one of our U.S. senators has said he will be proposing this. You know how fast Congress moves? Even if
