

CLERK: 20 ayes, 1 nay to go under call.

PRESIDENT: The motion carries. The house is under call. Members at your seats, please record your presence. Senator Beyer, if you are in your chair, you may record your presence. Senator Schmit, please. Members, please look up to the front and record your presence. Do you want call in votes or roll call or what, Senator Wesely? One member is excused at the present time. Senator Bernice, would you please record your presence. Thank you. Senator Lamb, Senator Morehead, Senator Vard Johnson. Senator Goll, please record your presence. Senator DeCamp, Senators Landis and Nichol, Senator Hartnett, and Senator Carsten. May we take call ins or do you want to record by some other way, Senator Wesely?

SENATOR WESELY: We could have a roll call in reverse order.

PRESIDENT: Very well, we will have a roll call in reverse order. Meanwhile, Senator Lamb, Senator Carsten, Senator Goll, and Senator Withem, Senators Landis and Nichol, Senator Hartnett, please.
