

is yours by virtue of being a human being, and it means as soon as you are in the world, you have those rights. And so as I said when I was talking to Senator Hall about it, you have got to have a baby gun, a mama gun, a daddy gun, grandma and grandpa gun. Everybody has to have that gun with them in the same way that the right to liberty, the right to life is theirs. So you read the language of that and either you are elevating this right to keep and bear arms to the level of these others or you are debasing them to the right to keep a gun. There is no law in this state that prohibits a proper and lawful use of a firearm, but if you put this thing into the Constitution, you are repealing the laws that are on the books right now, and all you law and order people, those of you who may be NRA members such as myself, think about that because you are always saying it is not the gun which is an inert object which commits the crime, it is the one holding it, but under this amendment, you cannot stop anybody from keeping that gun. And if you think I am not telling the truth, read the language of the amendment. Thank you.
