CLERK: (Read record vote. See pages 2247-48 of the Legislative Journal.) 47 ayes, 0 nays, 2 excused and not voting, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT: A majority of members having voted in the affirmative, the bill is declared passed. The Chair interrupts Final Reading to announce, on behalf of Senator Rod Johnson, that he has guests in the north balcony, 30 women who are from the Extension Group at Clay Center and their Coordinator. Thank you for coming down to the Legislature. If you'd stand we'd like to recognize you. We proceed with the reading of LB 563.

CLERK: Mr. President, if I might, right before that I have an explanation of vote to be inserted in the Journal. I also have a new resolution by Senator Lamb. (Read summary of LR 436. See pages 2248-49 of the Legislative Journal.)

Enrollment and Review reports 603 as correctly engrossed. That is signed by Senator Hall as Chair. (See pages 2249-50 of the Legislative Journal.)

(Read LB 563 on Final Reading.)

PRESIDENT: All provisions of law relative to procedure having been complied with, the question is, shall LB 563 pass? All those in favor vote aye, opposed vote nay. Have you all voted? Have you all voted on 563? Record the vote.

CLERK: (Read record vote. See pages 2250-51 of the Legislative Journal.) 46 ayes, 0 nays, 1 present and not voting, 2 excused and not voting, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT: A majority having voted in the affirmative, the bill is declared passed. We proceed to read LB 635 with the emergency clause.

CLERK: (Read LB 635 on Final Reading.)

PRESIDENT: All provisions of law relative to procedure having been complied with, the question is, shall LB 635 pass with the emergency clause attached? All those in favor vote aye, opposed vote nay. Have you all voted? Have you all voted on 635e?
