LB 635, 765, 768A, 768

Record the vote.

CLERK: (Read record vote. See pages 2251-52 of the Legislative Journal.) 44 ayes, 0 nays, 3 present and not voting, 2 excused and not voting, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT: A majority having voted in the affirmative, a sufficient majority having voted in the affirmative, the bill is declared passed with the emergency clause attached. We proceed to read LB 765.

CLERK: (Read LB 765 on Final Reading.)

PRESIDENT: All provisions of law relative to procedure having been complied with, the question is, shall the bill pass? All those in favor vote aye, opposed vote nay. Have you all voted? Have you all voted on 765? Please record your vote. Have you all voted? Record the vote, Mr. Clerk. Here's Senator Hartnett. Record the vote.

CLERK: (Read record vote. See pages 2252-53 of the Legislative Journal.) 45 ayes, 0 nays, 2 present and not voting, 2 excused and not voting, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT: A majority having voted in the affirmative, the bill is declared passed. We read now on Final Reading LB 768 with the emergency clause.

ASSISTANT CLERK: (Read LB 768 on Final Reading.)

PRESIDENT: Please record your vote on the Final Reading of LB 768 with the emergency clause. Have you all voted? Have you all voted? Record the vote, Mr. Clerk.

ASSISTANT CLERK: (Read record vote. See page 2253 of the Legislative Journal.) 44 ayes, 1 nay, 2 present and not voting, 2 excused and not voting, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT: A sufficient majority of 33 or more having voted in the affirmative, the bill is declared passed with the emergency clause attached. The bill is declared passed. We need now to read LB 768A with the emergency clause.
