LB 829A, 850A, 850

PRESIDENT: All provisions of law relative to procedure having been complied with, the question is, shall LB 829A pass? All those in favor vote aye, opposed vote nay. Have you all voted? Have you all voted? Record the vote.

CLERK: (Read record vote. See page 2259 of the Legislative Journal.) 43 ayes, 0 nays, 5 present and not voting, 1 excused and not voting, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT: A sufficient majority having voted in the affirmative, the bill is declared passed. Proceed to read LB 850. May I interrupt Final Reading, Mr. Clerk, to announce that Senator Carsten has guests in the north balcony, 15 seniors from Elmwood High School at Elmwood, and Senator Nelson has students from Trumble Elementary in Trumble, the fifth and sixth grade students with their teacher. We welcome you to the Legislature. Please stand and we'll recognize you. Proceed with LB 850.

ASSISTANT CLERK: (Read LB 850 on Final Reading.)

PRESIDENT: All provisions of law relative to procedure having been complied with, the question is, shall LB 850 pass? All those in favor vote aye, opposed vote nay. Have you all voted on final passage of LB 850? Please record your vote. Have you all voted? Record the vote.

CLERK: (Read record vote. See pages 2259-60 of the Legislative Journal.) 44 ayes, 0 nays, 4 present and not voting, 1 excused and not voting, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT: A sufficient majority of 33 or more members having voted in the affirmative, the bill is declared passed with the emergency clause attached. Proceed reading the appropriations bill.

CLERK: (Read LB 850A on Final Reading.)

PRESIDENT: All provisions of law relative to procedure having been complied with, the questions is, shall LB 850A pass? All those in favor vote aye, opposed vote no. Have you all voted? The A bill for LB 850, have you all voted? Record the vote.

CLERK: (Read record vote. See pages 2260-61 of the Legislative Journal.) 41 ayes, 1 nay, 6 present and not voting, 1 excused and not voting, Mr. President.
