LB 850A, 878

PRESIDENT: A majority having voted in the affirmative, the appropriations bill for 850 is declared passed. Proceed to LB 878.

CLERK: (Read LB 878 on Final Reading.)

PRESIDENT: All provisions of law relative to procedure having been complied with, the question is, shall LB 878 pass? All those in favor vote aye, opposed vote nay. Have you all voted on the final passage of LB 878? Please record your vote. The voting board is still open if members wish to record their Final Reading vote on LB 878. Have you all voted? Have you all voted? Have you all voted? Record the vote. Have you all voted? Senator Schmit.

SENATOR SCHMIT: I'd like to request a roll call vote, please.

PRESIDENT: Roll call vote has been requested.

SENATOR SCHMIT: And have everyone check in, if you would please.

PRESIDENT: We are on Final Reading, and check your green lights for a check in, members. Put your green light on, let's make sure that we have all members here. Members, please press your presence button, the green light up here. Senator Lamb, please. Members, please engage your green light showing your presence here. Senator Morehead, Senator Landis, Senator Barrett. We are on Final Reading. All unexcused members should be on the floor of the Legislature. Senators Landis and Barrett, please record your presence. One member is excused. Senator Barrett. All members are notified that a roll call vote has been requested on the final passage of LB 878. We understand that Senator Barrett is on his way. We haven't recorded it yet. A call in, we can't take a call in. A roll call vote has been requested. Thank you. If the Chair may take the privilege of then asking for the roll call to proceed in reverse order, is there objection? If not, the Clerk will call the roll in reverse order.

CLERK: (Roll call vote taken. See pages 2261-62 of the Legislative Journal.) 25 ayes, 22 nays, Mr. President, on passage of the bill.
