CLERK: (Read LB 881 on Final Reading.)

PRESIDENT: All provisions of law relative to procedure having been complied with, the question is, shall LB 881 pass? All those in favor vote aye, opposed vote nay. Have you all voted? Please record the vote.

CLERK: (Read record vote. See page 2262 of the Legislative Journal.) 48 ayes, 0 nays, 1 present and not voting, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT: A majority having voted in the affirmative, LB 881 is declared passed. We proceed now to LB 894.

ASSISTANT CLERK: (Read LB 894 on Final Reading.)

PRESIDENT: All provisions of law relative to procedure having been complied with, the questions is, shall LB 894 pass? All those in favor vote aye, opposed vote nay. Have you all voted? Record the vote.

CLERK: (Record vote read. See page 2263 of the Legislative Journal.) 47 ayes, 0 nays, 1 present and not voting, 1 excused and not voting, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT: A majority having voted in the affirmative, the bill is declared passed. Proceed to read LB 894A.

CLERK: (Read LB 894A on Final Reading.)

PRESIDENT: All provisions of law relative to law having been complied with, the question is, shall LB 894A pass? All those in favor vote aye, opposed vote nay. Have you all voted? Have you all voted? Record the vote.

CLERK: (Record vote read. See page 2264 of the Legislative Journal.) 45 ayes, 0 nays, 3 present and not voting, 1 excused and not voting, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT: A majority having voted in the affirmative, 894A is declared passed. We read now Final Reading for LB 900.
