

PRESIDENT: The argument then is finished on the motion to override the veto concerning mental retardation aid. All those in favor of the override vote aye, opposed no. The items under Section 4 had been divided so the question now is the override of the mental retardation aid item of \$1,270,000. Please record your vote. Please record your vote. The Chair will allow 20 seconds for you to record your vote on this line-item veto motion. Ten seconds to cast your vote aye or nay on the override motion for mental retardation aid. Time. Senator Warner, what do you wish to pursue?

SENATOR WARNER: Mr. President, I would ask for a check in...call of the house and roll call vote.

PRESIDENT: Members, please check in, please. We will have to take up the motion for the house to go under call. The question is, shall the house come under call? All those in favor vote aye, opposed vote nay. Record the vote.

CLERK: 38 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President, to go under call.

PRESIDENT: The motion carries. The house is under call. All members please check in on the green board. See that your light is on. Senator Warner, we might try to take call ins just to see how far along we get. You may still call in your vote to the Clerk on the motion to override the veto concerning mental retardation aid. Meantime, please check in with your green light button to show your presence. Senator Higgins, would you turn on your green light button, please. Senator Lynch. Yes.

SENATOR MARSH: Request a roll call vote.

PRESIDENT: Roll call vote has been requested. Senator Lynch. I believe we are all present who are not excused so we will proceed with a roll call vote on this question concerning mental retardation aid, the line-item veto thereof. The Clerk will call the roll aye or nay.

CLERK: (Roll call vote taken. See pages 2289-90 of the Legislative Journal.) 31 ayes, 16 nays, Mr. President, on the motion to override on the mental retardation funding.

PRESIDENT: The motion carries. We now proceed to the second question, the advocacy agencies. Senator Warner, do you wish to reopen?
