PRESIDENT: A call of the house has been requested. Shall the house come under call? All those in favor vote aye, opposed vote nay. Record the vote.

CLERK: 12 ayes, 0 nays to go under call.

PRESIDENT: We are under call. Members of the Legislature at your stations, please look up and see that your presence is indicated by the green light by your name. Members outside the Chamber, be advised that the house is under call and your presence is requested on the floor of the Legislature.
