SPEAKER NICHOL: Any other discussion on it? The question is the adoption of the Vard Johnson amendment. All those in favor vote aye, opposed nay. Record, Mr. Clerk.

SENATOR V. JOHNSON: Well, I better ask for a call of the house because a lot of folks are eating munchies. See if I can get a call of the house and do a roll call vote.

SPEAKER NICHOL: Question is, shall the house go under call? All those in favor vote aye, opposed nay. Record, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 7 ayes, 0 nays to go under call.

SPEAKER NICHOL: The house is under call. Will you please return to your desks and record your presence. Those not in the Chamber, please return to the Chamber and record your presence. Unauthorized personnel, please leave the floor. Senator Rupp, for what purpose do you rise?

SENATOR RUPP: Mr. Speaker, question of Senator Johnson.

SPEAKER NICHOL: Do you rise for a point of personal privilege or what?

SENATOR RUPP: Yes. Where is this amendment? Is it in the Journal or being distributed, or where is it?

SENATOR V. JOHNSON: It's on the Clerk's desk. It may have been printed in the Journal, but I do know that it is on the Clerk's desk. All this does is it just simply says that the half a cent increase in the sales tax, if it be done, which is on motor vehicles, will go to the General Fund for this current fiscal year. That is what it says.

SPEAKER NICHOL: Sergeant-at-Arms, will you please get the senators in. No one is excused. Everybody should be here and be at their desks. So, let's get rolling here, let's go. Senator Vard Johnson, did you wish to have a roll call vote? (Gavel.) Senator Vard Johnson, did you wish to have a roll call vote when we get here?
