SPEAKER NICHOL: Senator Warner, please. Senator Warner, please.

SENATOR WARNER: Mr. President, I need clarification of the amendment. Is there a sunset on this on the motor vehicle sales tax? Pardon.

SPEAKER NICHOL: Senator Landis, would you like to reply, please, so we can all hear.

SENATOR LANDIS: The amendment makes no reference to a sunset on the cap, if you will. That, I thought, was previously adopted to the bill by Senator Johnson on the first motion that was adopted. This is January 1 beginning to collect, and it is not terminated, just starts January 1. It makes no reference to the sunseting of the cap. That, I thought, was previously adopted.

SENATOR WARNER: That depends on how your amendment is drafted. I don't know if you struck out all preceding motions.

SENATOR LANDIS: No, I did not strike out all preceding amendments. I did not...

SPEAKER NICHOL: Would you please talk into the microphone so we can hear, please. Thank you.

SENATOR LANDIS: I did not strike all previous amendments.

SENATOR WARNER: Well I'm going to make my position clear. Some of you were led to believe that a compromise had been arrived at. That compromise that I was informed of said that there would be a cap on June 30. When I was told that, I found out that that was only half the story, later. The other half of the story is that the purpose of the cap is to add pressure to fund the patrol out of gas tax next session. That may be what you all want to do, but I do not. The fight may as well start here because it is going to be on next session. Those who had the agreement, that I was led to believe, the first time I was only told half. That is the issue you are dealing with. You are setting yourself up for the argument next year, which is fine,
