

SENATOR LANDIS: For those who would like a blow by blow one last time, this amendment does one simple thing. It says rather than starting the sales tax 90 days after the session, we'll start it January 1, 1987. It will bring in 25 million bucks, that is how much we are short in the coming year, roughly. With respect to the question of the cap on the sales tax for motor vehicles that has previously been adopted, that does sunset after, in essence, six months of operations. This tax does not. It starts a 4 percent sales tax January 1 and it runs until we change it, bring it back down or increase it. But the tax rate itself is not capped. It puts us in, I think, the best possible shape we could be in for the coming year. Secondly, it is consistent with the Appropriations Committee's recommendations for how to fund the budget and the veto overrides we accomplished earlier this afternoon. I move for the adoption of the amendment.
