SPEAKER NICHOL: The amendment fails. Do you have anything else, Mr. Clerk?

CLERK: Mr. President, yes, sir, I do. Senator Warner, I am back to your motion to indefinitely postpone, Senator.

SPEAKER NICHOL: Senator Warner, please.

SENATOR WARNER: No, I wouldn't do that.

CLERK: Mr. President, I then have an amendment from Senator DeCamp, essentially adding a new section saying this act shall become operative on August 1, 1986.

SPEAKER NICHOL: Senator DeCamp.

SENATOR DECAMP: I don't need that now, I don't think.

CLERK: Mr. President, in that case I have an amendment from Senator Pappas. Senator Pappas, no? I have nothing further on the bill, Mr. President.

SPEAKER NICHOL: Okay, we are back on the bill. Senator Warner, you want to talk about the bill? Oh, excuse me. Senator Vard Johnson, I guess it is a revenue bill. I'm sorry. Senator Warner.

SENATOR WARNER: I'd make a motion, Mr. President. I'll move reconsideration of the Landis amendment. I voted on the prevailing side. I voted no. And I do it...

SPEAKER NICHOL: Excuse me, Senator Warner, which one?

SENATOR WARNER: Senator Landis. The amendment that just failed to be adopted by a vote of 23 to 22, I think.

SPEAKER NICHOL: Did you want the motion read, or what, Senator Warner? Or did you just want to continue on speaking?

SENATOR WARNER: No. I move to reconsider Senator Landis's amendment that failed. I will speak on the amendment, if that is in order.
