

CLERK: Mr. President, Senator DeCamp would move to indefinitely postpone the bill.

SENATOR DECAMP: Mr. President, if there is going to be a tax increase, which obviously there is, my choice would be the sales tax. I'm not going to go into all the reasons. I am not going to go ahead with the motion. I'm just suggesting you vote against advancement of the bill and leave the only choice, the sales tax thing, on the other end that we've already put on final. So I'll withdraw that and go watch television.

PRESIDENT: I assume the motion is to advance. Do you wish to pursue that?

SENATOR V. JOHNSON: Yes, I would just move the bill be advanced.

PRESIDENT: Motion is the advancement of LB 31. I would ask for a machine vote. All those in favor vote aye, opposed vote nay. Motion is to advance the bill from Select File to final Enrollment and Review. Motion is to advance LB 31. Please record your vote. I assume most of you are here. Twenty seconds to record your vote. We'll see where we...

SENATOR V. JOHNSON: I'll ask for a call of the house to make sure everybody is here. We'll just do this by roll call vote.

PRESIDENT: After this vote is taken... Call of the house has been requested. All those in favor of calling the house vote aye, opposed vote nay. Record the vote.

CLERK: 20 ayes, 0 nays to go under call.

PRESIDENT: The motion carries. The house is under call. When we expedite our procedure and get this particular vote taken care of, we will stand at ease for the news program. All those members, please record your presence here in the Chamber. Senator Lamb, and Senator Schmit, and Senator Hefner. We have a call of the house under way.
