LB 31, 870

CLERK: (Roll call vote taken. See page 2310 of the Legislative Journal.) 18 ayes, 28 nays, Mr. President, on the motion to advance.

PRESIDENT: Motion fails. Senator Nichol.

SPEAKER NICHOL: Mr. President, Mr. President, if we are going across the hall we better get back here pretty quick because we are getting short on time, dangerously short on time. So don't make it long. Get back as soon as it is over, please.

PRESIDENT: The Legislature will be at ease for 10 to 15 minutes. The Speaker suggests 5 minutes.

EASE

SPEAKER NICHOL: The commentaries will still be going when we are through tonight, so come on, let's go. Thank you.

PRESIDENT: Return to the Legislative Chamber so that we may resume our business for the evening by taking up LB 870. Members, please return to the Legislative Chamber. All right. I think if Senator Warner is ready to go, we will resume our agenda with LB 870.

CLERK: Mr. President, the first item on 870 are E & R amendments to the bill.

PRESIDENT: Senator Nichol, would you take the E & R amendments.

SPEAKER NICHOL: Mr. President, I move the adoption of the E & R amendments.

PRESIDENT: You've heard the motion. All those in favor say aye. Opposed no. Motion carried. The amendments are adopted.

CLERK: Mr. President, Senator Goodrich had an amendment on page 1481. Senator, you want to withdraw that one?

SENATOR GOODRICH: Yes.

CLERK: Senator Goodrich would like to withdraw that amendment, Mr. President. The next motion I have is by Senator Goodrich to add the emergency clause to the bill.
