PRESIDENT: Motion is the adoption of the Goodrich amendment to LB 870. All those in favor vote aye, opposed vote nay. Please record your vote, aye or nay, on the Goodrich amendment to LB 870. The motion before the house is the Goodrich amendment to LB 870. Please record your vote, aye or nay. Have you all voted? Record the vote.

CLERK: 26 ayes, 4 nays, Mr. President, on adoption of Senator Goodrich's amendment.

PRESIDENT: The amendment is adopted.

CLERK: I have nothing further on the bill, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT: Senator Goodrich.

SENATOR GOODRICH: I move the bill be advanced.

PRESIDENT: Motion is to advance LB 870 from Select File. All those in favor say aye. Opposed nay. Motion carried. The bill is advanced. Next is LB 926.

CLERK: Mr. President, on 926, Senator Hall, I have E & R amendments on this bill, Senator.

SENATOR HALL: Mr. President, I would move the E & R amendments be adopted.

PRESIDENT: You've heard the motion. All those in favor say aye. Opposed no. Motion carried, the amendments are adopted.

CLERK: Senator, I have nothing further on the bill.

SENATOR HALL: Mr. President, I would move that LB 926 be advanced from Select File to E & R for Engrossing.

PRESIDENT: You've heard the motion to advance the bill from Select File. All those in favor say aye. Opposed nay. Motion carried. The bill is advanced. We go to 43.
