PRESIDENT: We have four excused.

SENATOR LANDIS: In that case, begin the roll call.

PRESIDENT: Clerk will call the roll. The motion is to advance LB 43 from Select File. Quiet in the Chamber, please.

CLERK: (Roll call vote taken. See page 2313 of the Legislative Journal.) 25 ayes, 15 nays, Mr. President, on the motion to advance LB 43.

PRESIDENT: LB 43 is advanced. Pick up 43A.

CLERK: Yes, sir, just a moment.

PRESIDENT: Not hurrying you.

CLERK: I know. Mr. President, 43A, is on Select File. The first item I have, Senator Hall, are E & R amendments.

SENATOR HALL: Mr. President, I'd move the E & R amendments be adopted.

PRESIDENT: You've heard the motion. All those in favor say aye. Opposed no. Motion carried. The amendments are adopted.

CLERK: Mr. President, I believe I have an amendment to the bill. Senator Landis, I assume you'll offer this amendment, Senator. This is a...

SENATOR LANDIS: That's right. The A bill needs to be amended because of this amendment down. So I'd offer the amendment to the A bill. (Landis amendment appears on pages 2313-14 of the Legislative Journal.)

PRESIDENT: The Landis amendment has been offered. Is there discussion? Is there discussion? Motion is the adoption of the Landis amendment. All those in favor vote.... Wait, I didn't see it. Senator Higgins.

SENATOR HIGGINS: Mr. President, I didn't understand. You say there is an amendment to the A bill? What is the amendment?

PRESIDENT: The amendment, I assume, conforms to the text of the
