PRESIDENT: You wish to also take up those now, Speaker Nichol? You wish to take those up now?

SPEAKER NICHOL: LB 645A and 1258.

PRESIDENT: Senator Schmit.

SENATOR SCHMIT: I assume that means immediately following LB 300?

PRESIDENT: That is what I'm trying to determine here. The house remains under call. Speaker Nichol, the question is, do those two bills that you mentioned go before LB 300 or after? Okay. LB 300 we'll take up now then. Yes, Senator Vickers.

SENATOR VICKERS: Mr. President, I guess I'd like to ask the Speaker, if he would, as to what the criteria is to determine which bills have to be amended. There may be some other bills that some of us may think might have to be amended as well.

SPEAKER NICHOL: Okay, let's just withdraw them both and see what happens.

SENATOR VICKERS: I just ask what the criteria is, Mr. Speaker.

SPEAKER NICHOL: Well, if you wish to know, I understand there is an adjournment motion coming very suddenly and should it come, which I am not promoting that, but if it should I think these two bills should be handled.

SENATOR VICKERS: Okay. Then I...that is fine. But I just wanted to know because I also had a motion on a bill that I thought might have some economic impact...

SPEAKER NICHOL: There are motions on all of these bills, some of them good, some of them little, some big, some don't want to take them. There is a conglomerate of motions here. You don't have much time, though, I'll tell you that.

SENATOR VICKERS: Okay, thank you.
