SENATOR BEYER: Let's see, the way I read it now, there was \$150,000 allotted to Nebraska Forest Service. What I am asking for is another \$320,000 and \$307,869 should be used for the operation of the rural fire program. The other would not be used for the rural fire program.

SENATOR LUNDY: The other being what?

SENATOR BEYER: The other \$150,000 is not being used for the rural fire program. Now I could be wrong but that is my understanding.

SENATOR LUNDY: So you are saying that in reality then you are asking for something over 200 percent increase in what has been allocated, is that correct?

SENATOR BEYER: Yes.

SENATOR LUNDY: Thank you.

PRESIDENT: Is there further discussion? I think Senator DeCamp wished to call the question, did you? Senator Beyer, did you have any closing, have any closing?

SENATOR BEYER: Just asking to have the bill brought back right now.

PRESIDENT: All right, the motion is to return the bill to Select File. All those in favor vote aye, opposed vote nay. Please record your vote on Senator Beyer's motion to return LB 1258 (sic) for a specific amendment. Please record your vote to return...on the motion to return the bill to Select File for specific amendment. Please record your vote aye or nay on the motion of Beyer to return the bill to Select File for specific amendment. Please record the vote, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 25 ayes, 8 nays, Mr. President, on the motion to return the bill.

PRESIDENT: The motion carries. The bill is now on Select File. Do you offer the motion formally, Senator?

SENATOR BEYER: Just to clarify a few things here. That 150,000 that the Appropriations Committee put in was money that is used for all the various services. The money that I am asking for is basically to be used for the shop and the rural fire programs.
