

So with that, I would ask your adoption of the amendment.

PRESIDENT: The motion is the adoption of the Beyer amendment. Is there discussion? If not, the motion is to adopt the amendment. All those in favor vote aye, opposed vote nay. Please record your vote on the adoption of the Beyer amendment. The motion is the adoption of the Beyer amendment to LB 1258 (sic). The Chair will allow 30 seconds. What do you want to do, Senator Beyer? Please record your vote if you wish to vote on Senator Beyer's amendment to 1258 (sic). Please record your vote on the motion of Senator Beyer to amend 1258 (sic). Record the vote, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 26 ayes, 10 nays on adoption of Senator Beyer's amendment, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT: The amendment is adopted. Do you wish to readvance?

SENATOR BEYER: I move to readvance the bill.

PRESIDENT: The motion is to readvance the bill from Select File. All those in favor say aye. Opposed no. Motion carried. The bill is advanced. Mr. Speaker, do you wish to make an explanation on the agenda?

SPEAKER NICHOL: Yes, Mr. President, we have some...and members of the Legislature, we have some time and it looks like we are getting along fairly well, so let's start at the beginning of that Final Reading with amendments, starting at 333, and after 967, insert 1259 and we will go as far as we can, and when we get to the place where...yes, 1258 is now but I am thinking of after 1258, then go to 333, and we will start down the line, and, Mr. President, after 967, insert 1259.

PRESIDENT: Right. We will now take up bills in this order, 333, 355, 355A, 921, 967, and 1259. LB 333. Okay, we are still on LB 645...we advanced LB 645A. Now we are on LB 1258.

CLERK: Mr. President, the first motion I have on 1258 is a motion by Senator Vard Johnson to return the bill for a specific amendment.

PRESIDENT: Senator Johnson.
