PRESIDENT: The bill is returned. It is now on Select File. Senator Johnson.

SENATOR V. JOHNSON: I would move the amendment as I explained a little bit earlier.

PRESIDENT: The motion is to adopt the amendment. No discussion? All those in favor of adopting the amendments under discussion vote aye, opposed vote nay. Record the vote.

CLERK: 28 ayes, 0 nays on the adoption of the amendment, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT: The amendment is adopted. Do you want to move to readvance the bill, Senator Hall?

SENATOR HALL: Mr. President, I move that LB 1258 be advanced from Select File to E & R for engrossing.

PRESIDENT: You have heard the motion to readvance the bill. All those in favor say aye. Opposed no. The motion carries. The bill is readvanced.

CLERK: Mr. President, Senator Lynch would move to return the bill for a specific amendment.

PRESIDENT: Senator Lynch.

SENATOR LYNCH: Mr. President, members, I will take as little time as necessary and possible. Not too long ago we discussed on this bill an amendment that would offer a special consideration for veterans who were disabled during their term of service. To be very frank, I was a disabled veteran during my term of service but I was a catcher on the 7th Army baseball team over in Germany. I was in the service at the time. There were many veterans who were disabled after they left the service in an automobile accident, became quadriplegics and have similar and the same problems as those who had military disablement. Also there are those who are disabled and need this kind of help. Now this amendment, and I am asking you to return it for the amendment, would simply return the same criteria...amend the bill to provide the same criteria for disability for those people as I just described. I would ask your consideration for this, go into more detail if necessary, and ask that you return to Select File for the consideration of this amendment.

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
