

PRESIDENT: The bill now is on Select File. Senator Chambers.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Mr. Chairman, although I was distracted by Senator Pirsch and didn't get to vote for the return, I am in favor of its return and I'm asking that you now adopt the amendment, and I will vote for it.

PRESIDENT: Thank you, Senator. Discussion? The motion is to adopt the amendment offered by Senator Chambers. All those in favor vote aye, opposed vote nay. Have you all voted? Record the vote, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 30 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President, on adoption of Senator Chambers' amendment to the bill.

PRESIDENT: The amendment is adopted.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: During this moment of euphoria I move that the bill be readvanced.

PRESIDENT: The motion is to readvance the bill from Select File. All those in favor say aye. Opposed nay. Motion carried, the bill is advanced to Enrollment and Review Final. Next is LB 355.

CLERK: Mr. President, on 355, I have a motion from Senator Wesely to return the bill for specific amendment.

PRESIDENT: Senator Wesely.

SENATOR WESELY: Thank you. Very briefly, Mr. President, Senator Goll, whose bill this is, and I sat down with Senator Lynch and the members of the physical therapists and the athletic trainers and we worked out an amendment essentially delaying the effective date of this bill dealing with athletic trainers to a date, I think it is October 1 of '87. It also changed one drafting error in Senator Lynch's amendment which we adopted so that athletic trainers that work for amateur athletic organizations would qualify under this act, and with this amendment, the bill was in a form that is agreeable with all parties. There will be work on the scope of practice element of the bill that will be worked on this summer and it will come back next year but I ask your support for this amendment.
