SENATOR SCHMIT: Mr. President, I just want to say that since Senator DeCamp used this opportunity to say he is going to offer a motion to recess that I would object to that. I think that is a very narrow-minded point of view and one which I would expect from someone at this time of the night, but not to be taken seriously, and I would hope we would continue to work as we have dedicated ourselves to work thus far.

PRESIDENT: Motion is to return the bill. All those in favor vote aye, opposed vote nay. Voting on a motion to return the bill to Select File for a specific amendment. Record the vote.

CLERK: 27 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President, on the motion to return the bill.

PRESIDENT: The bill is on Select File. Senator Vickers.

SENATOR VICKERS: I would just move adoption of the amendment.

PRESIDENT: The motion is the adoption of the Vickers amendment. Discussion? Please record your vote aye or nay. Motion is the adoption of the Vickers amendment to 1259. Please record your vote. Please record your vote aye or nay on the Vickers amendment. Record the vote, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 26 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President, on adoption of the amendment.

PRESIDENT: The amendment is adopted. Senator Vickers.

SENATOR VICKERS: I move to readvance the bill to E & R Final.

PRESIDENT: Motion is to readvance 1259. All those in favor say aye. Opposed no. Motion carried. The bill readvanced. Matters for the record, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: Mr. President, I have a motion to recess from Senator DeCamp.

PRESIDENT: All right. The motion is to recess until...what time?
