LB 812, 889

SENATOR PAPPAS: So they could actually save money? Papers lose money but now they can save money?

SENATOR V. JOHNSON: Yep, you have got it.

PRESIDENT: Is there further discussion? The motion is to return 889 to Select File for specific amendment. All those in favor vote aye, opposed vote nay. Record the vote.

CLERK: 28 ayes, 1 nay, Mr. President, on the motion to return the bill.

PRESIDENT: The bill is on Select File, Senator. The motion is the adoption of the amendment by Senator Johnson. Is there discussion? If not, please vote aye or nay on the amendment. Please vote on Senator Johnson's amendment aye or nay to LB 889. Record the vote.

CLERK: 28 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President, on adoption of the amendment.

PRESIDENT: The amendment is adopted. Readvance.

SENATOR V. JOHNSON: I move the bill be readvanced.

PRESIDENT: Motion is to readvance the bill. Discussion? You have heard the motion. All those in favor say aye. Opposed nay. The motion carried. The bill is readvanced to Enrollment and Review. Next is LB 812.

CLERK: Mr. President, Senator Miller would move to return LB 812 to Select File for specific amendment.

PRESIDENT: Senator Miller.

SENATOR MILLER: Mr. President and members, this would prevent us from changing horses in midstream. If we pass 812, we will have a condition where we will require residency in a county where a person is elected. We already have people that have filed that are running that this would be changing horses in midstream, and this would correct that situation.

PRESIDENT: Senator Barrett.

SENATOR BARRETT: Mr. President and members, another friendly amendment. I would urge the body to adopt the Miller amendment.
