CLERK: (Read record vote as found on page 2344 of the Legislative Journal.) 48 ayes, 0 nays, 1 present and not voting, Mr. President.

SPEAKER NICHOL: The majority of members of the Legislature having voted in the affirmative, LB 1143A passes. LB 1158.

CLERK: (Read LB 1158 on Final Reading.)

SPEAKER NICHOL: All provisions of law relative to procedure having been complied with, the question is, shall LB 1158 pass? All those in favor vote aye, opposed nay. Have you all voted? Record, Mr. Clerk, please.

CLERK: Read record vote as found on page 2345 of the Legislative Journal.) 45 ayes, 3 nays, 1 present and not voting, Mr. President.

SPEAKER NICHOL: A majority of the members of the Legislature having voted in the affirmative, LB 1158 passes. LB 1160, please.

ASSISTANT CLERK: (Read LB 1160 on Final Reading.)

SPEAKER NICHOL: All provisions of law relative to procedure having been complied with, the question is, shall LB 1160 pass? All those in favor vote aye, opposed nay. Incidentally, Mr. Clerk, I had a complaint that you weren't pronouncing some of those words very clearly on page 3 and 4. (Laughter.) Have you all voted? Record, Mr. Clerk, please.

ASSISTANT CLERK: (Read record vote as found on pages 2345-46 of the Legislative Journal.) The vote is 45 ayes, 0 nays, 4 present and not voting, Mr. President.
