SENATOR CARSTEN: A majority of members of the Legislature having voted in the affirmative, LB 799 passes with the emergency clause attached. We move to LB 817, Mr. Clerk.

ASSISTANT CLERK: (Read LB 817 on Final Reading.)

SENATOR CARSTEN: All provisions of law relative to procedure having been complied with, the question is, shall LB 817 pass? All those in favor will vote aye, those opposed vote no. Have you all voted? Have you all voted? Record, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: (Record vote read. See page 2361 of the Legislative Journal.) 46 ayes, 0 nays, 2 excused and not voting, 1 present and not voting, Mr. President.

SENATOR CARSTEN: A majority of members of the Legislature having voted in the affirmative, LB 817 passes.
