LB 525, 1049

Final Reading of LB 525.

CLERK: Mr. President, with respect to LB 525, I have amendments on the bill. Senator Warner and Senator Hoagland had an amendment that was printed earlier this year, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT: Senator Hoagland. Senator Hoagland, your amendment is up on a bill. Senator Hoagland, your amendment is up on LE 525.

SENATOR HOAGLAND: (Response inaudible.)

CLERK: Mr. President, in that case Senator Haberman had a motion on this bill.

PRESIDENT: Senator Haberman.

SENATOR HABERMAN: No.

CLERK: The next motion I have on the bill is by...Senator Haberman, you had a second, Senator. Mr. President, Senator Warner had amendments to this bill. Senator Warner wishes to withdraw. And, Mr. President, Senator Lamb, you want to withdraw yours. (Read LB 525 on Final Reading.)

PRESIDENT: All provisions of law relative to procedure having been complied with, the question is, shall LE 525 pass? All those in favor vote aye, opposed vote nay. Have you all voted? Have you all voted on 525? Record the vote, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: (Record vote read as found on pages 2372-73 of the Legislative Journal.) 42 ayes, 5 nays, 2 present and not voting, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT: A majority of the members having voted in the affirmative, the bill is declared passed. By a request of the introducer we will pass over LB 819 and proceed to LB 1049 with the emergency clause.

CLERK: Mr. President, LB 1049, I have a motion from Senator Haberman to return the bill for a specific amendment.

PRESIDENT: Senator Haberman.

SENATOR HABERMAN: Mr. President, for a matter of record, the bill has a flaw and I want to read into the record what the flaw
