PRESIDENT: May we have a little bit (gavel) quieter conversational tone, please. Go ahead, Senator.

SENATOR HABERMAN: ...later on. On page 13 it says, if the Nebraska Commission for Special Education has not negotiated a compact agreement to establish interstate residential special education schools within one or more of such states within 12 months, the Nebraska Commission for Special Education shall be dissolved. It does not say 12 months from when. The intent of the legislation is 12 months after the passage of the bill. So I'd like to have the records show that the Special Education Commission shall dissolve 12 months after the passage of the bill. Thank you, Mr. President. I'll withdraw the amendment.

PRESIDENT: Thank you, Senator. Anything further on the bill.

CLERK: No, sir, there is nothing further on this bill.

PRESIDENT: Okay, we'll read 1049 then.

CLERK: (Read LB 1049 on Final Reading.)

PRESIDENT: All provisions of law relative to procedure having been complied with, the question is, shall LB 1049 pass with the emergency clause attached? All those in favor vote aye, opposed vote nay. Please record your vote. Have you all voted? Record the vote, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: (Record vote read as found on pages 2373-74 of the Legislative Journal.) 49 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President, on passage of the bill.

PRESIDENT: A sufficient majority of 33 or more having voted in the affirmative, the bill is declared passed with the emergency clause attached. Next is 1049A.

CLERK: (Read LB 1049A on Final Reading.)

PRESIDENT: All provisions of law relative to procedure having been complied with, the question is, shall LB 1049A pass with the emergency clause attached?
