CLERK: Mr. President, if I might right before that, some items for the record. 442 is a resolution by Senator Labedz, Warner, Schmit and Goodrich. (Read explanation of LR 442.) To be laid over. 443 by Senator DeCamp. (Read explanation of LR 443. See pages 2377-80 in the Legislative Journal.)
