

on this issue. Vote against the Final Reading passage. I ask unanimous consent to withdraw the motion.

PRESIDENT: The motion is withdrawn. Is the bill ready for reading?

CLERK: I have nothing further, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT: We will read...we have...we will now read the Final Reading of LB 807 and there has been a request for a roll call vote in reverse order.

CLERK: (Read LB 807 on Final Reading.)

PRESIDENT: All provisions of law relative to procedure having been complied with, the question is, shall LB 807 pass? All those in favor vote aye, opposed vote nay. Shall it pass with the emergency clause attached? All those in favor vote aye, opposed vote nay. Roll call vote.

CLERK: (Roll call vote taken. (See page 2381 of the Legislative Journal.) 28 ayes, 20 nays, Mr. President, with the emergency clause attached.

PRESIDENT: The bill fails to pass with the emergency clause. Now we will have a vote on the question, shall LB 807 pass without the emergency clause? And we will go to a machine vote on this one. All those in favor vote aye, opposed vote nay. Have you all voted? Have you all voted? Record the vote.

CLERK: (Read record vote. See pages 2381-82 of the Legislative Journal.) 31 ayes, 18 nays, Mr. President, on the passage of the bill without the emergency clause.

PRESIDENT: A majority of the members having voted in the affirmative, the bill is declared passed. We proceed to LB 812. We will now...Final Reading for 885.

CLERK: Mr. President, Senator Haberman, you had an amendment on 885. Senator, do you want to withdraw that? Is that right? Okay. (Read LB 885 on Final Reading.)

PRESIDENT: All provisions of law relative to procedure having been complied with, the question is, shall LB 885 pass? All those in favor vote aye, opposed vote nay. Have you all voted who care to vote? Have you all voted on final passage of 885?
