LB 237, 807, 890

CLERK: (Read LB 890 on Final Reading.)

PRESIDENT: All provisions of law relative to procedure having been complied with, the question is, shall LB 890 pass? All those in favor vote aye, opposed vote nay. Please record your vote on the final passage of LB 890. Have you all voted? Have you voted? Have you all voted? Record the vote.

CLERK: (Read record vote. See page 2384 of the Legislative Journal.) 28 ayes, 16 nays, 4 present and not voting, 1 excused and not voting, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT: A majority having voted in the affirmative, the bill is declared passed. Proceed now to a motion by Senator Nichol, unless you have something for the record first.

CLERK: No, sir. Well yes, sir, I do. Mr. President, your Committee on Enrollment and Review reports LB 807 as correctly Enrolled. That is signed by Senator Hall.

PRESIDENT: The Chair recognizes the Speaker, Senator Nichol.

SPEAKER NICHOL: Mr. President, members of the Legislature, I move we suspend the rules so that we can read the bills today instead of having to wait for tomorrow.

PRESIDENT: Motion is to suspend the rules to take up the bills bracketed for Final Reading tomorrow. Is there discussion? If not, the motion is to suspend the rules for that purpose. All those in favor vote aye, opposed vote nay. Motion is to suspend the rules to take up bills bracketed for Final Reading for the 16th of April. Please record your vote. Have you all voted? Record the vote.

CLERK: 41 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President, on the motion to suspend the rules to proceed with the reading of those bills.

PRESIDENT: The motion carries. The rules are suspended. We then take up LB 237.
