LB 237, 237A, 783, 833

CLERK: (Read record vote. See pages 2385-86 of the Legislative Journal.) 49 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President, on passage of the bill.

PRESIDENT: A majority of the members having voted in the affirmative, LB 237 is declared passed. Is there an A bill, 237A.

CLERK: (Read LB 237A on Final Reading.)

PRESIDENT: All provisions of law relative to procedure having been complied with, the question is, shall LB 237A pass? All those in favor vote aye, opposed vote nay. Voting on 237A. Record your vote. Have you all voted? Record the vote.

CLERK: (Read record vote. See page 2386 of the Legislative Journal.) 44 ayes, 2 nays, 3 present and not voting, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT: A majority of the members of the Legislature having voted in the affirmative, the bill is declared passed. We proceed to 783.

CLERK: (Read LB 783 on Final Reading.)

PRESIDENT: All provisions of law relative to procedure having been complied with, the question is, shall LB 783 pass with the emergency clause attached? All those in favor vote aye, opposed vote nay. Have you all voted on the final passage of 783? Please record your vote. Have you all voted? Have you all voted? Record the vote.

CLERK: (Read record vote. See page 2387 of the Legislative Journal.) 48 ayes, 0 nays, 1 present and not voting, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT: A majority having voted in the affirmative, the bill is declared passed. We proceed to LB 833.

ASSISTANT CLERK: (Read LB 833 on Final Reading.)

PRESIDENT: All provisions of law relative to procedure having been complied with, the question is, shall LB 833 pass? All those in favor vote aye, opposed vote nay. Have you all voted? Have you all voted? Have you all voted? Record the vote.
