LB 956, 997, 997A, 1001

CLERK: (Record vote read. See page 2392 of the Legislative Journal.) 44 ayes, 2 nays, 1 present and not voting, 2 excused and not voting, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT: A majority of members having voted in the affirmative, LB 956 is declared passed. We proceed to LB 997.

CLERK: (Read LB 997 on Final Reading.)

PRESIDENT: All provisions of law relative to procedure having been complied with, the question is whether LB 997 shall pass with the emergency clause attached. All those in favor vote aye, opposed vote nay. Have you all voted on the final passage of LE 997? Have you all voted? Record the vote.

CLERK: (Record vote read. See pages 2393-94 of the Legislative Journal.) 44 ayes, 0 nays, 2 present and not voting, 3 excused and not voting, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT: A sufficient majority having voted in the affirmative, LB 997 is declared passed with the emergency clause attached. We proceed to the A bill of 997.

CLERK: (Read LB 997A on Final Reading.)

PRESIDENT: All provisions of law relative to procedure having been complied with, the question is, shall LB 997A pass? Have you all voted on the final passage of the A bill for 997? Please record your vote if you wish to do so. Have you all voted? Record the...go ahead, Pat, go ahead. Oh, sorry, Pat, I didn't...we will record you up here.

CLERK: (Record vote read. See page 2394 of the Legislative Journal.) 43 ayes, 0 nays, 3 present and not voting, 3 excused and not voting, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT: A majority of the Legislature having voted in the affirmative, LB 997A is declared passed. We proceed to LB 1001 with the emergency clause.

ASSISTANT CLERK: (Read LB 1001 on Final Reading.)

PRESIDENT: All provisions of law relative to procedure having been complied with, the question is shall bill 1001 pass with the emergency clause attached? All those in favor vote aye,
