SENATOR V. JOHNSON: I withdraw the motion.

PRESIDENT: Read the bill, LB 1142.

CLERK: (Read LB 1142 on Final Reading.)

PRESIDENT: All provisions of law relative to procedure having been complied with, the question is, shall LB 1142 pass? All those in favor vote aye, opposed vote nay. Please record your vote on the final passage of 1142. Have you all voted? Have you all voted? Record the vote. Senator Johnson.

SENATOR V. JOHNSON: I am going to ask for a call of the house and I am going to ask for a roll-a-call-a-vote...a roll-a-call-a-vote. It's getting kind of late. It's the old "Svede" a comin' out. Like to see some of the greens come out, too.

PRESIDENT: Call of the house has been requested. All those in...we are on Final Reading. Just check in, Final. We are in a virtual call of the house anyway as we were on Final Reading, so members check in. We will start a new vote with the roll call...with "a roll-a-call-a-vote" when it comes up. Senator Vickers, Senator Scofield, Senator Chizek. Senators Scofield and Chizek. Vard.

SENATOR V. JOHNSON: Well, why don't we start? This is one of the later bills tonight, let's start with Senator Nelson and go up the middle and then Senator Withem and go up one side and then Senator Harris.

PRESIDENT: It's confusing enough to have a "roll-a-call-a-vote" but I think we are all here with the exception of...no, we are all here that are not excused. The Clerk will call the roll aye or nay. Final passage of 1142.

CLERK: (Roll call vote taken. See page 2401 of the Legislative Journal.) 22 ayes, 23 nays, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT: Not having a sufficient majority of the membership in the affirmative, LB 1142 fails on Final Reading. Next we move to LB 1177.

CLERK: Mr. President, right before that, two new resolutions, LR 444 by Senators Pappas and Morehead. (Read explanation.)
