CLERK: (Read LB 43A on Final Reading.)

PRESIDENT: All provisions of law relative to procedure having been complied with, the question is, shall LB 43A pass? All those in favor vote aye, opposed vote nay. Members, please record your vote, aye or nay, on the final passage of LB 43A. Have you all voted? Record the vote, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: (Read record vote. See pages 2411-12 of the Legislative Journal.) 27 ayes, 16 nays, 3 present and not voting, 3 excused and not voting, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT: A majority of the members having voted in the affirmative, LB 43A is declared passed. The Clerk will read LB 201.

CLERK: Mr. President, on 201 the first item I have on the bill...Senator Wesely, you had amendments printed. I understand you want to withdraw those, Senator.
