And, Senator Higgins, please record your presence. Senator Nichol.

CLERK: Senator Pirsch voting yes. Senator Schmit voting yes.

PRESIDENT: You may call in your...

CLERK: Senator Goodrich voting no. Senator Labeledz voting no.

PRESIDENT: Have you all voted? Have you all voted? You may call in your vote to the Clerk, aye or nay. Have you all voted? Record the vote, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: (Record vote read as found on pages 2424-25 of the Legislative Journal.) 25 ayes, 22 nays, Mr. President, on passage of the bill.

PRESIDENT: A majority of members having voted in the affirmative, LB 600A is declared passed. The Clerk will proceed with the reading of LB 603. By request of the introducer we will pass over LB 603 until later at the end of the Final Reading. Is there objection? Hearing none, so ordered. Proceed with LB 645A with the emergency clause.

CLERK: (Read LB 645A on Final Reading.)

PRESIDENT: All provisions of law relative to procedure having been complied with, the question is, shall LB 645A pass with the emergency clause attached? All those in favor vote aye, opposed vote nay. Please record your vote on the final passage of 645A. Have you all voted? Have you all voted? Record the vote.

CLERK: (Record vote read as found on pages 2425-26 of the Legislative Journal.) 43 ayes, 2 nays, 2 present and not voting, 2 excused and not voting, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT: A majority having voted in the affirmative, the bill is declared passed. I'm afraid maybe our guests have left here, but I wanted to say that Senator Chronister had 57 fourth grade students from Schuyler grade school in the gallery here with their teacher. Their visit will be recorded in the record. The Chair asks the Clerk to read LB 812.
