ASSISTANT CLERK: (Record vote read as found on pages 2428-29 of the Legislative Journal.) The vote is 45 ayes, 0 nays, 2 present and not voting, 2 excused and not voting, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT: A sufficient majority having voted in the affirmative, LB 870 is declared passed with the emergency clause attached. LB 889.

ASSISTANT CLERK: (Read LB 889 on Final Reading.)

PRESIDENT: (Microphone not turned on immediately.) ...shall LB 889 pass? All those in favor vote aye, opposed vote nay. Have you all voted? Record the vote, Mr. Clerk.

ASSISTANT CLERK: (Record vote read as found on pages 2429-30 of the Legislative Journal.) 46 ayes, 0 nays, 1 present and not voting, 2 excused and not voting, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT: A majority of members having voted in the affirmative, LB 911 (sic) is declared passed. We proceed with the reading of LB 921. (sic) Instead we're going to go...complete...read the Final Reading of LB 911.

CLERK: Mr. President, I have a motion on that bill. Senator Hoagland would move to return 911 to Select for a specific amendment, to strike the enacting clause.

PRESIDENT: Senator Hoagland.

SENATOR HOAGLAND: Mr. President and colleagues, I recognize there may be sufficient votes to pass this bill, at least without the emergency clause, but I would certainly like to take this last effort, and I know some others may want to speak on the issue too, to attempt to dissuade you from making this significant and, I think, most unfortunate change in the way the liquor laws are administered in the State of Nebraska. I understand this is a local control bill, but this is a local control with a vengeance bill. And I recognize this is a popular bill, but this is a bill that throws out the baby with the bath water. It goes much, much further than it has to do to correct the current problem some people are experiencing around
