

fiscal year, so that if there was any problem earning that revenue, they still are there to be lapsed or reduced in a deficit bill, if that was necessary. But if receipts are sound, then much of this \$37 million of delayed and deferred maintenance over the years, at some point, will need to be addressed, will not be as big. It is a sound investment. The other facility is available. It authorizes, from the revolving funds, in the event, and obviously the Governor will have the option to negotiate, if it is unsatisfactory, obviously nothing will be acquired. But it is available now. You have a situation of a willing seller, which is significantly different than if you have to acquire space under conditions in which there is not a willing seller.

PRESIDENT: Call of the house has been requested. The question is, shall the house come under call? All those in favor vote aye, opposed vote nay. Record the vote.

CLERK: 20 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT: Motion carries, the house is under call. All members, please check in on the green board, please. Record your presence. Two members are excused at the present time. Senator Lamb, Senator Schmit, Senator Wesely, Senator Rupp, Senator Lynch, Senator Pappas, Senator Haberman, Senator Labeledz. Members, please check in, the house is under call. Everyone is here who is not excused. Roll call vote has been requested. The question is, shall LB 1252 be overridden? The Clerk will call the roll. Call the roll, Pat, we are all here. The Clerk will call the roll aye or nay.

CLERK: (Roll call vote taken. See page 2451 of the Legislative Journal.) 30 ayes, 14 nays, Mr. President, on the override.
