CLERK: 29 ayes, 0 nays to go under call, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT: That carries. We're under call. Now record your presence, members. Put your green lights on again. Please record your presence. Senator Hefner, would you put your green light on. Senator Lamb, Senator Schmit, Senator Lynch, Senator Conway, Senator Morehead, Senator Pappas, Senator Nichol, Senator Haberman, Senator Labedz, Senator Landis, Senator Hoagland and...Senator Landis and Senator Lamb. Senator Lamb and Senator...Senator Lamb. The house is under call. I think we'll proceed with the roll call in reverse order as is requested. Silence in the Chambers so the Clerk may hear your vote, and record your vote aye or nay, shall 1129 become law notwithstanding the objections of the Governor? Call the roll.

CLERK: (Roll call vote taken as found on pages 2455-56 of the Legislative Journal.) 31 ayes, 16 nays, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT: The motion carries and as a result of that vote, LB 1129 becomes law. What do we have, Patrick?

CLERK: Mr. President, I have a few miscellaneous resolutions. The first is LR 444. That is offered by Senators Pappas and Morehead. It is found on page 2401 of the Journal.

PRESIDENT: Senator Morehead. Senator Pappas.

SENATOR PAPPAS: Mr. President and colleagues, this is another resolution on Nebraskaland Days and anytime you have Senator Morehead's and Senator Pappas's name together, my great esteemed colleague, you know that it is a very good resolution and I ask for its adoption so we can save time.

PRESIDENT: Senator Harris. Senator Morehead. Okay. Any further discussion? All those in favor of the resolution 444 vote aye, opposed vote nay. Record the vote.

CLERK: 31 ayes, 0 nays on adoption of LR 444, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT: The resolution is adopted.
