SENATOR LABEDZ: I hope part of that applause is for what I'm going to say now. I've been here now about 10 years. I came in 1976. I was a very frightened lady and I looked for help. So I sought out the people that I thought were the leaders of the Legislature. I did find one. He taught me how to get things done, get bills passed, how to wheel and deal, and do everything necessary to get a bill passed. Now I'm saying farewell to a very good friend of mine, someone that was here at the time that I came and it saddens me very much. But I assure you the man I'm going to say good-bye to, and the tears in my eyes are not necessarily for this person, it is because of what Senator Cal Carsten had to say. So I want you all to join me in bidding farewell to Senator John DeCamp. (Laughter.) (Applause.) Senator DeCamp, would you please come over here. We have a plaque that we'd like to give you.

SENATOR PAPPAS: Senator DeCamp, in appreciation of all the great deeds you did for the state, and possibly against the state, (laughter) there are so many things, and because we may not have the opportunity to do this for you next year, we decided to give you this blank plaque. Somehow you may put something in there that you like yourself, which you usually do in bills and other things as you go along. (Laughter.)

SENATOR DECAMP: I don't want a plaque yet! (Applause.)

SENATOR LUNDY: I'll tell you, between the last pair that have been here, this is a difficult thing to follow, but I wonder if Senator Tim Hall would like to come up a moment, please. All of us know of Tim's service to the Unicameral and for that outstanding service that he's been so good at in chairing the E & R Committee. This guy is always there. He learned quickly and we are real proud of him. This has always been an assignment that is given to the youngest newcomer. Tim has fulfilled this just great. We are real proud of you, Tim, and want you to have this little gift to remember this session that you've served with your fellow human beings. (Applause.)
