PRESIDENT: The Chair recognizes Senator Hefner.

SENATOR HEFNER: Mr. President and members of the body, the Miscellaneous Subjects Committee met yesterday to confirm the Secretary of State appointment, Susan M. Symonds, to the Accountability & Disclosure Commission. Miss Symonds is from O'Neill. And the vote was unanimous on that. Then we had a Governor's appointment of Lynn V. Ferer to the Accountability & Disclosure Commission. She is from Omaha. We also took action and heard from former Senator Don Dworak, the Governor's appointment to the Liquor Control Commission. I think most of you know former Senator Dworak. He comes from Columbus and he has been heading up the Department of Economic Development. But since that time he is not in that position anymore and so now he has been appointed to serve a term on the Liquor Control Commission. The next one was the Governor's appointment of Lewis E. Trowbridge to the Arts Council. Mr. Trowbridge is an accountant from Omaha. The committee met and voted unanimously to approve these appointments. So at this time I would move that the Legislature accept these appointments as I have presented them. Thank you.

PRESIDENT: You have heard the report of Senator Hefner on the approval of the nominees and the appointments. Is there discussion? If not, all those in favor of these appointments and their approval vote aye, opposed vote no. The Clerk will call the roll. May we have quiet in the Chamber, please, for the calling of the roll. Call the roll, Mr. Clerk.

ASSISTANT CLERK: (Read the roll call vote as found on pages 72-73 of the Legislative Journal.)

PRESIDENT: Are there other senators who have not voted that wish to vote? Senator Peterson, did you wish to vote?

ASSISTANT CLERK: Senator Peterson voting yes. The vote is 44 ayes, 0 nays on the committee report, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT: The committee report and confirmation of the appointments therein is approved. That completes the confirmation reports. The Clerk will read the motion concerning our entrance into the agenda of Final Reading. Members, may I have your attention, please. (Gavel.) We
