PRESIDENT: One moment. Thank you for making the point of order, Senator Chambers. The Chair...this has rushed through my mind on occasion. I am told that constitutionally the special sessions can consider without a doubt confirmations to offices and that in the field of other resolutions that in the past previous special sessions have considered resolutions that are clearly outside of the Governor's call and from the standpoint that there is no legislation enacted, I would rule unprecedented, therefore, that consideration of resolutions outside the defined scope of the Governor's call for legislation is in order.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: I move we adjourn.

PRESIDENT: The motion is to adjourn. It is not debatable. The Clerk will call the roll. The motion is to adjourn.

CLERK: (Roll call vote taken.) 14 ayes, 26 nays on the motion to adjourn, Mr. President.
