

thorough study investigation on the entire subject, report to the entire Legislature and make sure that all information that could make this state hang out from any liability standpoint, in any way, is brought out and that's done under the committee structure of the Legislature, under legislative oversight authority, and I think we would be remiss if we didn't. It's not bad to have more committees involved in things if they want. To specifically answer, the Banking Committee will do one of the best jobs and most thorough jobs you ever saw on this particular subject, no matter what happens at the Exec Board.

SENATOR REMMERS: I would say that I had no problem with either one of the resolutions that are being considered in the Exec Committee. Again, my main purpose was that we do not just walk away from it. I think that it's brought to the attention of the Legislature and I'm sure that there will be a follow-up on it and with that in mind, I ask that my resolution be withdrawn, my motion be withdrawn.

PRESIDENT: Senator Remmers is withdrawing his motion. Senator Pappas has a motion before us.

SENATOR PAPPAS: Mr. President, I move that the Legislative Journal for the seventh day be approved as prepared by our competent, trustworthy Clerk.

PRESIDENT: You have heard that motion. All those in favor say aye. Opposed no. The motion carried. Senator Nichol, do you wish to...?

SPEAKER NICHOL: I was going to talk on Senator Remmers' motion, but...and my purpose was going to be to keep us on an even keel, but I won't need to make that speech now. But I do appreciate your coming in and conducting yourselves as you have to accomplish the purpose for which we came. I want you to know that I appreciate it. See you next special session.

PRESIDENT: The Chair recognizes Senator Morehead.

SENATOR MOREHEAD: Mr. President, Senator Hannibal wants me to wait to be recognized. I would move that the 89th Legislature, First Special Session of the Legislature, having finished all business before it, now on this day, September 25, 1985, adjourn sine die.
