SENATOR LAMB: We are recessed until one-thirty. Thank you.

SENATOR MARSH PRESIDING

SENATOR MARSH: The Legislature will reconvene. Please indicate your presence. Will the Legislature please come to order. We need your presence. Will the Sergeant-at-Arms please try and find the missing senators. Thank you, Senator Haberman. Senator Remmers, when we do have a quorum you are the first name on the list. Senator Lynch, if you will check in, we would appreciate it. Senator Scofield. The Clerk will record.

CLERK: There is a quorum present, Madam President.

SENATOR MARSH: Mr. Clerk, do you have something to read into the record?

CLERK: Yes, Madam President, I do. I have new resolutions. LR 6 offered by Senators Vickers, Schmit and Rod Johnson. (Read LR 6 as found on pages 63-64 of the Legislative Journal.) That will be laid over. LR 7 by Senators Vickers and Harris. (Read LR 7 as found on pages 64-65 of the Legislative Journal.) That too will be laid over, Madam President.

Madam President, your Committee on Public Works whose Chairman is Senator Schmit reports LB 4 as indefinitely postponed. That is signed by Senator Schmit.

Your Committee on Revenue whose Chairman is Senator Vard Johnson reports LB 17 indefinitely postponed, 23, 24, 25 and 26, all of those reported indefinitely postponed, all signed by Senator Vard Johnson.

Madam President, when we left discussion of LB 1 this morning, the committee amendments had been offered. There was then pending a motion to amend the committee amendments by Senators Remmers, DeCamp, Beutler and Vard Johnson. That motion is now before us.
