

SENATOR SCHMIT: Yes.

SENATOR WARNER: There is one other one that we are...that I am aware of specifically which deals with the military who were going to come in with a \$38,000 deficit that are not going to now, as I understand it. And that was related to the change in construction plans that they had for a new unit that the National Guard will be having. I think they are...at one time it was to all be, as I recall, located in Omaha. Now a portion of it is Grand Island and a portion is Lincoln and a portion in Omaha.

SENATOR SCHMIT: Thank you, Senator.

SENATOR MARSH: We are now ready and we will vote on Section 4. Have you all voted? It takes 25 votes. Have you all voted? The Clerk will record.

CLERK: 25 ayes, 1 nay on adoption of committee amendment Section 4, Madam President.

SENATOR MARSH: Section 4 is adopted. We are ready for Section 5. Senator Warner.

SENATOR WARNER: Quickly, Section 5 is the Governor's budget. The committee recommendation and the Governor's budget recommendation is the same and I would move the adoption of the reduction in the budget of \$16,419.

SENATOR MARSH: We are now ready and will vote on the adoption of Section 5. I would venture that we are going to have to go under call if we do not have 25 on the floor who are working senators this afternoon. The Clerk will record.

CLERK: 26 ayes, 2 nays on adoption of committee amendment Section 5, Madam President.

SENATOR MARSH: Section 5 is adopted. We are ready for Section 6.

SENATOR WARNER: Mr. President, I move adoption of amendment Section 6. The Lieutenant Governor is \$833. No specific thing identified, the same as the Governor's.

SENATOR MARSH: We are now ready to vote on Section 6.
