

Those in favor signify by voting aye, opposed no. The Clerk will record.

CLERK: 25 ayes, 1 nay on adoption of the committee amendment as it relates to Section 5 (sic) of the amendment.

SENATOR MARSH: Section 6.

SENATOR WARNER: Mr. President, I move adoption of Section 6 (sic). It relates to the Secretary of State. The dollar amount is the same as the Governor but we do have a specific item that is a small dollar amount of \$2900 identifying reminder cars for domestic corporation annual tax be discontinued. And the reason for doing that, and we will probably have to follow it up with legislation...well, will follow it up with legislation. There is a significant time period between the date when the forms are now sent out and when they are due, or at least when they are delinquent. And because of that time gap, they sometimes find it necessary to refile, or remind them that it is due. And the second car does generate money. Of course, if they fail to file, why they subsequently pay both the penalty and interest on what is due or they are dissolved as a corporation. But we felt in the long run that perhaps that law could be changed and revised some, have some small reduction in cost and still perhaps receive the money on a more timely basis. The total dollar cut is the same as the Governor's. I move its adoption.

SENATOR MARSH: The Secretary of State section, we are now ready to vote. Vote aye for support, no for opposition. The Clerk will record.

CLERK: 27 ayes, 1 nay on adoption of the amendment as it relates to the Secretary of State's office, Madam President.

SENATOR MARSH: It is adopted. We are ready for Auditor of Public Accounts.

SENATOR WARNER: Mr. President, I move the adoption. This...the reduction in the General Fund is the same as that as proposed by the Governor. It is not specified but in addition to that the committee amendment would increase the cash fund appropriation by \$450,000 for the auditor. The reason for doing that was when we made a reduction during the regular session. And you will recall we reduced the
