SENATOR MARSH: One minute.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: And maybe "the Legislature" is having its finest hour because what is happening now really typifies what the Legislature is about, nonsense, time wasted, running around in a circle going nowhere. And that is what the ultimate end of all this is going to be. If strong leadership was to be asserted, we would just stop it now. Why create problems for these agencies without solving the problem that all this misery is supposed to deal with? It is creating hurt for no purpose. We ought to just call it to a halt and come back in January.

SENATOR MARSH: Fifteen seconds.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: You are not going to get 33 signatures to call another special session and that would be a preposterous thing to do anyway. This is one time I am glad that people can look at me and see a difference between me and everybody else.

SENATOR MARSH: Time. We are now ready and will vote on the amendment regarding the Attorney General's budget. The Clerk will record.

CLERK: 25 ayes, 2 nays, Madam President, on adoption of the amendment as it relates to the Attorney General's Office.

SENATOR MARSH: The amendment is adopted. Senator Warner.

SENATOR WARNER: Mr. President, I move the adoption of the State Treasurer amendment number 10. Before I do that, let me say because I assume we will not run much longer and a couple of others have made the suggestion as well, if in the morning there is on the Clerk's desk the sheets that identify the agencies and some of these I know there is no particular disagreement, other agencies there would be perhaps a great deal, in order to provide members an opportunity to have looked through it, if those of you who have particular agencies that you want to address amendments to or discuss the proposal would identify those to the Clerk on the sheet that he has, then in the morning I will just move adoption of all amendments that the committee has other than those agencies which someone had indicated an interest
