

tomorrow. So, it is up to you. With that, we'll move on to LB 1. Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: Mr. President, LB 1 was the bill introduced by the Speaker at the request of the Governor. (Title read.) The bill was considered yesterday, Mr. President. At that time there were Sections 1 through, I believe, 10 were adopted of the committee amendment. Senator Warner.

SPEAKER NICHOL: Senator Warner, please.

CLERK: Senator, do I understand that you want to proceed this morning with adoption of that portion of the committee amendment that has not been excepted out at this point by other members?

SENATOR WARNER: I will move adoption of those sections, those agencies that have not been requested to be pulled out.

CLERK: Mr. President, the request that I have on my desk for separate discussion include the following sections of the committee amendment. Sections 11, 14, 16, 21, 23, 28, 36, 37, 38, 41, 47 and 60. Those sections have been asked to be addressed separately, Mr. President, and pursuant to Senator Warner's suggestion, those will be separated out.

SPEAKER NICHOL: And, Senator Warner, do I understand correctly that we are voting on the adoptions other than those numbers listed by the Clerk?

SENATOR WARNER: Yes. Mr. President, members of the Legislature, if I...so the members will know, if you wrote down numbers 11, the amendment is the Department of Education; 14 is the Department of Revenue; 16 is the Department of Agriculture; 21 is Institutions; 23, Roads; 28 was Game and Parks; 36 was the Board of State Colleges, Board of Trustees; 37 is all of the State Colleges, Chadron, Kearney, Peru and Wayne; 38, University of Nebraska; 41 which is the State Patrol; 47, Department of Economic Development and 60 is DPI, electric boiler, which is a capital construction. Is that right? Excuse me, that is the Lied Center.

CLERK: Yes, sir.
