

SENATOR WARNER: That section, but that's the specific. I'm sorry.

SPEAKER NICHOL: So you are moving the adoption of all of those sections except those mentioned by you. Is that correct?

SENATOR WARNER: Yes, Mr. President.

SPEAKER NICHOL: All right. Is there further discussion on Senator Warner's motion? Senator Haberman.

SENATOR HABERMAN: Mr. Speaker, I was just going to ask Senator Warner to pass out a list of those and he just now named them, so he answered my question.

SPEAKER NICHOL: All right, thank you. Senator Nelson.

SENATOR NELSON: Mr. Speaker, maybe I haven't kept up as well as I should. I had a couple of questions on a couple departments, one within the bill on the Masters Program at Kearney. Maybe I should address this to Senator Warner. I think the bill states, it's the intent, which in essence is to contain the Masters Program at Kearney, Nebraska. I have one question there. I have a question on the noxious weed program under the Department of Agriculture. I guess I think of all of these musk thistles completely uncontained and I'm not here to complain about any one part of the budget and add some more. I have another question, ADC to the unborn. Is that locked in by statute, the increase there? And I have another one under Department of Education and I don't think there was a cut or anything in that and I was unable to determine it on educating the volunteer firemen. This is a fund of about \$135,000 that has been handled by the Education Department. I think that they probably don't feel that that was within their scope and they would like to get rid of it and so on, but again, that is a fund, about five or six thousand volunteer firemen throughout the state get their training. Now maybe...and I wondered, that's four points in my mind.

SPEAKER NICHOL: Senator Warner, the first two will be taken up later since they are excluded. Is that correct?

SENATOR WARNER: That's correct.
